**Tinker Time: Tuesday, March 12th** STEAM activities with Ms. Olsen.

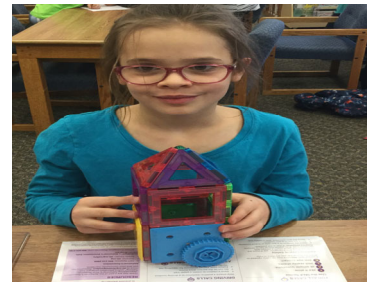
