Taxes are infamous for being complex and frustrating, and it's no surprise that every year more people seek filing assistance. In the 2012FY, nearly 10 million people sought help on their taxes— over 10 thousand more than the previous year (IRS). To address the difficulty, one of the major goals we set out to accomplish was to create a site that was more navigationally friendly than the IRS site, while still focusing on the essentials of tax information. We've created guides for different financial situation, e.g., students, parents, or service members, where we've pulled out the significant tax forms, credits, and deductibles applicable to that group.
